Dear Parents/Guardians,

The 6th grade students are starting a study review for their upcoming 1st nine weeks history test on Friday, October 12, 2018. This test will count as a test grade for US History. Students have received a study packet on Tuesday, October 2. Students are to look at their Study Log to determine what flashcard numbers they are responsible for nightly. I have asked students to study a minimum of 15 minutes each night. However, they need to have mastered that night's flashcard numbers before they stop studying. (This could be longer than 15 minutes) I have asked students to lightly cross off flashcards that they can answer without hesitation multiple times in a row. This way, they can focus more time on "problem" cards. As the studying progresses, I told students they can go back and study "problem" cards in addition to the ones for that night's focus. Please sign your child's study log nightly. Students will receive two warm-up quizzes over the flashcards from the night before to make sure they are studying.
